Where will Winter School 2020 take place?

All sessions as part of Winter School 2020 will take place on Zoom.

What will I need to attend Winter School?

A functional computer/laptop and a stable internet connection. A pair of headphones is advised for better sound/voice experience.

Am I required to have done any prior reading to attend Winter School?

Although there are no prerequisites to attend Winter School, some sessions require some prior reading or other material to engage with, which will be specified and circulated in advance.
